Be forewarned this restaurant is not for the faint hearted. Lord David West (he bought the title on E-bay) who owns and runs it, is one of London's most colourful (and rich) characters. Reputed to be worth over £100m David spend over two years building both the restaurant and adjoining club, HeyJo. David also hired Cherie Blair to fight her husband's Government in Court over then proposed smoking ban in his premises (unsuccessfully).
